


# Buncombe Trails

## Brick House Recreation Area (Newberry County)

-  Blue Trail (5.75 miles)
-  Purple Trail (9.0 miles)
-  White Trail (12.7 miles)
-  Green Trail (1.25 miles)
-  Gray Trail (0.75 mile)
-  Red Trail (2.25 miles)
-  Palmetto Trail (8.0 miles)

## **Description of Buncombe Course:**

**Start at Trailhead near Campsite #15 - Brick House Campground  
Follow Blue and Yellow blazes approximately 4 1/2 miles, Blue blazes end, continue on straight following Purple and Yellow blazes. Yellow blazes denote the Palmetto Trail.**

**At approximately 10 miles, Purple and Yellow separate, turn left and continue following Purple blazes.**

**Purple ends at approximately 14 miles, road crossing and aid station. From the aid station, follow White blazes for the next 13 miles.**

**At the junction where the White blazes end, turn left onto a short 1 1/4 miles marked with Green blazes.**

**At the end of the Green Blazes, cross the road to find an aid station.**

**From the aid station, follow Red blazes until they end at the Blue/Yellow junction. Turn right and continue on Blue/Yellow back to the finish.**

**All intersections and road crossings will be marked with orange ribbons and orange flags.**

**Single ribbon on right - Stay straight**

**Double ribbon on right - Turn right**

**Double ribbon on left - Turn left**

**At most road crossings, the trail continues directly across, however, there are a couple gravel roads where the trail is down the road a short distance - these places will be well-marked.**

**Fully-stocked Aid stations are located at approximately Miles 9, 14, 20.5 and 28. Water will be dropped at approximately Miles 5.5, 18.5 and 15.5.**
